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Your best bet is to get the debt collectors name and address. Debt collectors break the rules all the time. They're not under any legal requirement to accept smaller payments over a period of time. Here in the United States, the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act protects debtors from predatory collection tactics, and many other countries have used this act as a model to create their own legislation to outlaw these unethical types of collections. You should be well aware of your rights under the above act before dealing with the collection agency. This act prohibits Collection Agency Harassment. There is an entire section of the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA) that regulates debt collection calls to third parties. Each state limits a debt collector's right to sue you for repayment. Visa debt collectors are required to abide by the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA). The act also protects consumer privacy, even after death. Spouses are responsible, even if they didn't co-sign, for any debt accumulated during marriage if they live in a community property state and the estate can't cover the debt. If there is a lawyer representing the estate or other responsible party, the collection agency is required to speak with them and not continue to contact other parties. If they are unsuccessful, they will most likely "assign" or "sell" the debt to a collection agency. Exceptions to state statutes may include federal debt such as government loans, child support, alimony and tax debt.

According to the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau, the laws that limit what debt collectors can do and say are the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA), the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA), several federal laws that apply to creditors as well as debt collectors, and a patchwork of state laws. The TCPA also lets consumers take legal action against telemarketers who don't honor the national do-not-call list and collect \$500 per call, for every phone call beyond the first one. This means that the person you are dealing with might not even be the original party that you owe. This is especially true when dealing with consumer debt collection. The Act ensures that debt collection agencies don't use abusive and deceptive tactics toward consumer debtors. Sometimes, they threaten or use abusive language to compel the debtors to pay back the required amount.
