The biggest differences between the statutes are that the California statute applies to creditors (not just debt collectors) and unlike federal law, California law prohibits some actions by consumers (such as going into debt without intending to repay it or knowing there's no reasonable probability of being able to repay it). Knowing your rights as a debtor helps you avoid major problems that could put you at a disadvantage. A collector may contact your target debtor in person, by mail, telephone, telegram (oddly enough), or fax. These sorts of garnishments can get tricky because if the debtor is married part of that refund belongs to the spouse. What can a debt collector really do? Consumer debt is incurred by a person to purchase personal property, services or obtain money on credit, for personal, family, or household purposes. Under the FCEUA, the person who owes the debt is referred to as a "Consumer," who can only be a natural person residing in Pennsylvania who owes or is alleged to owe a debt.

Many consumers don't realize that they are guaranteed protection under the law. That's because collectors don't always tell you the name of the collection agency they work for or where it's based. Use any false or misleading statements, such as imply that they are attorneys or government representatives, imply that you have committed a crime; hint that they work for a credit bureau, say you will be arrested if you don't pay the debt, or use a false name. Debt collectors must send consumers a "debt validation letter" outlining important details, including the amount owed, the collection agency's name and how consumers can dispute the debt. The FDCPA requires that, within five days of first calling you, the debt collector must send you a written notice of the debt, including the amount, name of creditor, information about how to dispute the debt if you believe you do not owe the debt or if there has been a mistake. A debt collector is prohibited from engaging in any conduct a normal person would find to be harassing, oppressive, or abusive.

What are the 7 most common FDCPA violations? You are unable to submit an application for any loans. Once you have done so, a debt collector may only contact you to inform you that they are ceasing communication with you or are actually filing a lawsuit against you. Debt collector harassment can be either written or verbal. But keep in mind that this letter won't stop a debt collector from suing you to collect a debt. Together with several other laws, these steps detail actions that include the different ways debtors can be contacted by debt collectors. To verify legitimacy within a court summons, look for any type of confirmation of pending actions that exist between the various parties involved. The United States Supreme Court held in *Heintz vs Jenkins*, 514 U.S. If the creditor or collector cannot produce the proper documentation, you may ask the court to dismiss the lawsuit. The Fair Debt Collection Practices Act protects you from deceptive debt collection attempts. Read publications from the Federal Trade Commission, and read the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act. If you believe you're being contacted by a scammer, don't wait to report them to the Federal Trade Commission and your Attorney General's office. They are paid on a fee or commission basis. If you are being harassed by debt collectors then the most obvious step to take is to call the police. Speak to the debt collection agency at least once before resorting to writing the letter to see if you can resolve the issue over the telephone. They cannot discuss your debt with neighbors, relatives who aren't obligated to pay the debt, or co-workers. You cannot go to jail for bad debt. One false notion many debtors fear is that they are worried if they don't pay they will go to jail. Other allegations include trying to pay property taxes on the house when plaintiff was already paying them, and billing him for it after the fact. Of course, there is no law that says you have to talk to them, so always feel free to ignore their calls. If you have been approached by a collection agency for a debt owed, Dolman Law Group, advises you to check with the Florida Office of Financial Regulation to be certain that the agency is registered with the state. Federal law prohibits creditors from seizing all forms of Social Security benefits. Social Security payments, some pensions, several public assistance or benefits and some insurance or annuities payments are exempt from garnishment in Texas.

Make it clear to the collector that you know your rights; the company may be more likely to leave you alone if it is clear that you are not an easy target. One effect of this provision is that debt collectors are not permitted to leave voicemail messages if the voicemail is not private or if it is shared with your children, roommates, or is monitored by your employer. The point is you are not required to work with them at all, including not talking to them. Keep any voicemails and letters of correspondence, including ones you sent to them. Keep a log of all calls and letters from them. Do not prevent the cellphone calls either. Another 13% had to do with communication tactics and recurring phone calls at inconvenient times of the day. If possible, have a witness with you during the phone conversation to testify to the validity of your complaint.

The collection agency's ability to collect debts and the tactics they employ are just as important as what percentage they keep. Most companies are not going to change their ways unless it is in their best interest to do so. Tell the company that you understand your rights--you do not have to pay interest or fees and the company cannot attempt to collect on the debt without verifying it. Avoid trouble by understanding the consequences of defaulting on a payday loan. Not understanding a charge off can lead to the debtor negotiating incorrectly with the creditor, or taking other steps that are disadvantageous to the debtor. We would rather spend our time pursuing a debt that we can collect. One common method creditors use to collect judgments is wage garnishment. If you don't pay them, a collection agency can sue you or impose a wage garnishment to pay off the debt. They are lying. They can negotiate any debt that they choose to, they just want to keep the odds in their favor because they get paid on commission. You don't want that to happen. Debt collectors just want to be paid, and it is up to you to convince them that your offer of payment is better than no payment at all. The reasoning is simple: Once you're frustrated enough you'll agree to make a payment on the debt just to make the calls stop.

A consumer educated in fair debt collection practices, alters the balance of power, drying up the market for such sleazy debt collection companies. When the account number and social security numbers are punched in, the computer promptly supplies an up-to-the-minute account balance. If you have an unusual name, the collector calls all numbers with that name, looking for a relative. Tell them that you are keeping notes of the times of the calls and the language used, and that you may file a complaint against them. In fact, if a process server attempts to serve you multiple times and is not successful in doing so, the plaintiff may try a different method, which is "service by publication". If you don't read your local legal newspaper, which is the DeKalb Champion for DeKalb County, you may not know when this "service by publication" occurs. "I didn't know my rights so I had to prove who I was."

The debt collector is not allowed to ask details about your bankruptcy attorney-like whether you have paid them, when you are filing, etc. All they need to know is the attorney's name and contact information. If you decide to use an attorney to help you with your debt or to file bankruptcy, just give the debt collection agency your attorney's information. Federal law prohibits debt collectors from threatening you, but this doesn't mean they won't try to use fear to motivate you to pay off the full amount. 7.
